### [Week 12 August 13-19](#)

It's dinner time Saturday and your refrigerator just stopped working. You need a new one right away. With so many options, which one should you buy? Never fear – the Library's website gives you 24/7 access to Consumer Reports, and many other magazines. Read some reviews and you're ready to hit the sales.

In the left column, under **Research** click **Electronic Resources**.

Click the title or the icon for **Ebscohost**; then on the Ebscohost page, click **Continue**.

Under the basic search box, click **Advanced Search**.

On the Advanced Search page, type **refrigerators** in the top Search box. Under **Search Options**, in the **Limit your results** area, type **Consumer Reports** in the **Publication** box. Click **Search**.

The newest article is first. Under the synopsis, click **PDF Full Text** to read the entire article.

**Hunt #12:** What food was used to test evenness of temperature in the freezers?

Type other products into the search box to see if Consumer Reports has reviewed them. Type a different magazine title into the **Publication** box, or leave that box blank for more hits. Search for the same term using different **Search Modes**.

**Week 11 August 6-12**

In the right column, under **What's New...** click **Websites of the Month**

Click the title or photo of the **2010 Hunterdon County 4 & Agricultural Fair**.

**Hunt #11:** What are the dates of the Fair, and how much will it cost you to get in?

Blossoming Out

In the left column, click **SHOWS AND EXHIBITS** to see what kinds of animals, veggies and crafts will be on display at the Fair. Next, click back to the **Websites of the Month** page and click **Hunterdon County Parks and Recreation**. On the Parks website, click in the box at the top and check out the all facilities and summer events.

*Water Wisdom:*

Fill in the missing words in these water-related novels. (Hint: Look up the authors in the Online Catalog.)

**Week 10 July 30 – August 5**

In the gold bar at the top, click **Electronic Resources**

On the list on the left, click **Health & Medicine**

Three sources of health information are listed. Click **Health Source: Consumer Edition**.

Type  into the search box and hit the Enter key or click Search..

**Hunt #10:** According to the July/Aug2010 *American Fitness* magazine, what is the main reason many teens do not choose to eat more whole grain foods? **HINT:** Click **HTML Full Text** or **PDF Full Text** under the synopsis to read the whole article. (HTML is the text of the article; PDF is a picture of the magazine page.)

Blossoming Out

Go back to the **Health & Medicine** page. Click **Health Reference Center** and type  into the Basic Search box. Explore the different kinds of sources, including Images and News Articles. For more specialized information, try the same search using **Health Source: Nursing/Academic Edition**. Did you notice that many articles you can read in our Electronic Resources are from journals the Library does not subscribe to in print?

*Water Wisdom:* "Water, water everywhere but not a \_\_\_\_\_ to \_\_\_\_\_."

**Week 9 July 23-29**

On the bottom-right, click the **red, white & blue DEMOCRAT** box.

In the All Text Search box, type

Click on the article dated July 1, 2010.

**Hunt #9:** What devise did the author suggest for catching bait? What bait would he catch?

Blossoming Out

Go back to the search page. Type your last name to see articles about yourself. Next, in the lower section under “Browse an Issue”, enter a date to see the news of that day – be sure to use the *exact* date format AND it must be a Thursday, the day the Democrat is published. Or click “Jump to a month” and peruse any month.

### Week 8 July 16-22

In the center, under the changing picture, click **CLICK HERE to view all programs**

Under **New Programs**, click inside the red **August Rocks! at HCL** box.

*Hunt #8:* Name *one* of the two bands performing at the Library in August.

Go back to the Upcoming Events page. Take a look at the Recurring Programs and click on any that intrigue you. Click the phrase **CLICK HERE** to sign up for a program. See how easy it is to register for Library events!

### Week 7 July 9-15

On the right column under Reader’s Services, click **Join a Bookclub**.

Click Friends Book Club.

Click on the title chosen as the One Book New Jersey book.

*Hunt #7:* What is the name and age of the main character in this book?

### Blossoming Out

Go back to the Friends Book Club page. Click any title to read more about it and put it on Hold for yourself if you like. At the bottom of the page “**Looking for something to read? CLICK HERE to see books that have been discussed in past meetings.**” gives you a list of discussion-worthy and thought-provoking titles.

*Water Wisdom:* “He’s really in \_\_\_\_\_ water.”

### Week 6 July 2-8

In the center under the Programs slideshow, click **Library Use Value Calculator**.

Type a 1 (number one) into every box.

*Hunt #6:* What would you have to pay if you used every Library service just once?

### Blossoming Out

Click the “Reset Form” box to clear all the number one’s. Fill in the boxes with the real numbers of services you use. Congratulate yourself on being a clever and thrifty Library user.

*Water Wisdom:* “\_\_\_\_\_ is thicker than water.”

### Week 5 June 25- July 1

On the right side under **Book and Media Lists**, click **Booklists for Adults**.

In the center under the picture, click on **ALA’s Notable Books for 2010**.

Under **Fiction**. Click the title **Year of the Flood**.

*Hunt #5:* Who is the author of this book?

### Blossoming Out

In the box on the right, click **Link to NoveList** to see reviews, author information, and reading suggestions.

*Water Wisdom:* “It’s all water under the \_\_\_\_\_.” *OR (same idea)* “It’s all water over the \_\_\_\_\_.”

### Week 4 June 18-24

Going down the shore?...to Croatia?...on a road trip? You can lighten your suitcases by “packing” virtual books instead of paper or even CD ones. The Library provides downloadable audiobooks and eBooks – load your choices onto a PC, iPOD, MP3 or other listening device and take them on vacation. Or even on your daily commute.

At the lower/center of the homepage click the red, pink & black box that says “download...”.

This brings you to Listen NJ NW, our source for downloadable audiobooks and eBooks.

Scroll down to the row of book covers labeled **Always Available Audiobooks**

Click the ➤ to the right of the first 5 books to scroll through this category. Or click **View All**

“**Always Available Audiobooks**”... at the bottom of the box, to view them a page at a time.

*Hunt #4:* There are at least 3 books with dates in the titles. Name 2 of them.

### Blossoming Out

On the right side of ListenNJ’s homepage, click the red **Now offering eBooks!** box to find books you can read on your computer. Or click **BROWSE BY SUBJECT** and discover new titles in your favorite subjects.

### Week 3 June 11-17

In the center box, left column under “Guides to...” click **Genealogy**.

Click **Maps from the Beers Atlas of Hunterdon County**.

*Hunt #3:* Which 2 old towns on the list are now better known by other names?

### Blossoming Out:

If your browser will allow, open the map for your town and find the old name for your street and the name of the people who owned your property when the map was made.

*Water Wisdom:* “You can \_\_\_\_\_ a \_\_\_\_\_ to water but you can’t make him \_\_\_\_\_.”

### Week 2 June 4-10

In the top-right corner, click on the link to **My Account** (in white letters).

Type your library **Barcode** number and your **Password** (a 4-digit PIN), then click **Log In**

Click on the white words **My Account** on the top-right.

Click on the blue words **Items Out** in the grey bar under the picture of the Library.

*Hunt #2:* In what order are the **Items Out** listed?

### Blossoming Out:

Click on the drop-down arrow next to the **Sort by:** box. Sort your list by call number. Now click on any white in a blue circle to see the date you checked out that item.

*Water Wisdom:* “\_\_\_\_\_ waters run \_\_\_\_\_.”

### Week 1 May 28-June 3

On the gold bar across the top of our page, click on “**Online Catalog**”.

In the box next to **Keyword search for:** type the words **water your mind** then click **Go!**

Look on the line **Publisher, Date:** to find the oldest item on your list of ‘hits’.

Click on the [Availability](#) box at the bottom of the entry for this item.

Click on the phrase "[Click here to see items from all branches...](#)"

*Hunt #1:* Which branches owns this item?

Click the **Full Display** box. Click the author's name to see other works the Library owns.
