These fine organizations, despite limited budgets, believe their clients and customers deserve only gently-used books which are not obsolete. Please pre-sort your donations carefully. Each group's specific needs are described within.

Unusable items - always become expensive landfill

- \* catalogs
- \* old computer, legal, medical & business books
- \* brittle paper, broken spines, damaged covers, mildew, missing pages, smelly, stains, torn, waterlogged, or yellow-with-age

Rarely-needed items - see exceptions within

- \* encyclopedias
- \* magazines
- \* Readers' Digests
- \* textbooks

Most of these groups have limited space and staff; therefore, it is advisable to call ahead and schedule your delivery with the appropriate person.
