Join Austrian chef, food critic and writer Arno Schmidt as he talks about long-gone restaurants, what fashionable people ate years ago, a little history about French as menu language, and some anecdotes about famous restaurateurs and their clients. Chef Arno Schmidt worked at such hotels as *The Grand Royal* in Stockholm, the *Grand Victoria* in Zermatt and the *Regency* before becoming the executive chef of the prestigious Waldorf Astoria New York from 1969 to 1979. He then worked as a Food and Beverage Director at the Helmsley Hotel and at the Plaza Hotel from 1984 to 1986. Phyllis Hanes, food critic of The Christian Science Monitor, called Schmidt "one of the very best chefs in the country".
