Every fall, the monarch begins its migration south to an overwintering site. In the spring the monarch leaves its winter roost and heads northward, about half way back, to lay its eggs on milkweed plants. The offspring of this monarch must continue the journey north on its own. In the fall, this new generation will begin the migration cycle south. John DeMarrais continues where his Sept. 2017 talk left off. He will be showing more photos of butterflies and discussing their interesting behaviors in the garden.
