### *“Three Special Gardens in the St. Lawrence Valley of Canada” by Cindy Hedin*

**Travel with Cindy Hedin to visit 3 very special gardens in the St. Lawrence valley. Les Jardins de Quatre-Vents, north of Quebec, is the creation of Frank Cabot who founded the Garden Conservancy. Impressive vistas, reflecting ponds and semi-formal flower beds give a serene tranquility to this 20 acre garden. Much smaller, but still very impressive is Jardin Hemerocalle Charlevoix.**

**Created in a smallish backyard by a passionate daylily devotee, this garden displays an amazing variety of plants, hosta, peonies, iris &, of course, daylilies. Further south and west, on an island in the river, is the Montreal Botanical Garden, a spectacular place! There was an amazing alpine garden, trial beds of vegetables & ornamentals, and rose gardens bursting with blooms. In the Japanese garden, find a touch of New Jersey, the bonsai collection of the late George LeBolt of Nutley. Cindy is a retired librarian and an avid gardener who is a member of the NJ State Chrysanthemum Society.**
