Wildlife Corridors

Join us for an informative discussion about various wilderness proposals including the need for wildlife corridors to connect our increasingly fragmented natural lands and threats to our federal lands. The symposium begins with Nancy Carringer giving a light-hearted history of the Great Old Broads for Wilderness, a national grassroots organization led by women, created to preserve and protect wilderness and wild lands. Jody Alessandrine, TNC Director of Land Preservation, will give a presentation on Bobcat Alley, a natural habitat in New Jersey designed to protect our last remaining wild cats. NJ District 7 Congressional Candidate Tom Malinowski is scheduled to speak as well.
