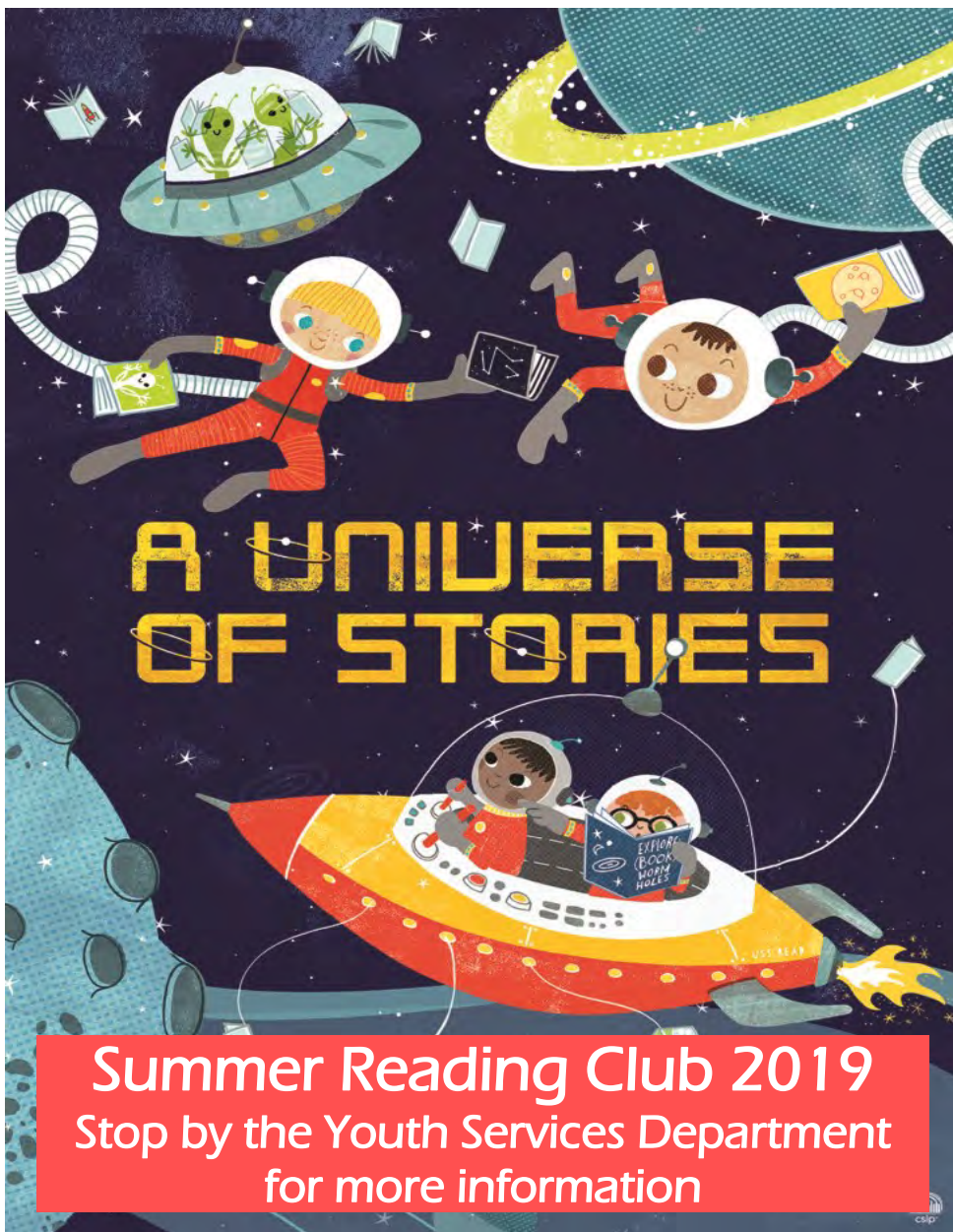

# NCB Exhibits

## May

**Breathtaking Scenes of Nature & Man Photography** by James C. Amon  
Jim's work has been exhibited in galleries & museums throughout New Jersey, and published in magazines. For 29 years Amon was the executive director of the D&R Canal Commission, guiding development of the park and administering a regulatory program to protect the canal from the harmful impacts of new development. In 2005 he became the director of stewardship for the D&R Greenway Land Trust, managing over 100 nature preserves, of approximately 4,000 acres. He retired in 2015.

## **Hidden Treasures** by Nelson Jecas

Nelson (posing here with the Flemington Dinosaur) has been treasure hunting for over 40 years. Although he still uses shovels, brushes and screen sifters when appropriate, Nelson incorporates new technology like metal detectors and probes while hunting for buried treasures. His finds include discoveries from as far as Bulgaria and South America, and as near as the Jersey shore.
