Castles & Cathedrals: Architectural Wonders by Henrietta Maneva

Born and raised in Bulgaria, Henrietta's first sentence was "Give me paper to draw on." Inspired by masters like Carlo Callodi and Hans Christian Anderson, she branched out from pen-and-ink illustrations of fashion design to portraits in watercolor, tempera and oil. After moving to Austria in 1997 and the US in 1999, she discovered the joy in painting architecture in watercolor. Her show features unique buildings from all over the world, often from intriguing perspectives of this award-winning artist.

Handmade Paraguayan Crafts from the travels of Kathy Reid & Family

The whole Reid family enjoys seeking out beautiful traditional handicrafts like this Nanduti lace embroidery. Nanduti is "spider web" in Guarani, the indigenous language of Paraguay.

Inspired by the beauty of our rural New Jersey landscape, Annandale artist Rosanna Hunt reveals her own colorful style, influenced by major New Jersey artists: W. Entry Drop Off: completed entries must be dropped off at the Hunterdon County Library Headquarters (314 Route 12, Flemington, NJ) on **Saturday, December 1 from 1-5 or Sunday, December 2 from 1-5**
