- JF Atwater, Richard. **MR. POPPER'S PENGUINS**
The unexpected delivery of a large crate containing an Antarctic penguin changes the life and fortunes of Mr. Popper, a house painter obsessed by dreams of Polar exploration.
- JF Barrie, J.M. **PETER PAN**
The Darling children, Wendy, Michael and John are whisked off to NeverNeverLand by the adventurous boy Peter Pan.
- JF Cameron, Ann. **MORE STORIES JULIAN TELLS**
Julian has more great stories to tell, but sometimes his way with words gets him into trouble. (one of a series)
- JF Cleary, Beverly. **BEEZUS AND RAMONA**
Beezus knows she's supposed to love her little sister, but four-year-old Ramona is her biggest problem. (one of a series)
- JF Dahl, Roald. **JAMES AND THE GIANT PEACH**
James is unhappy living with his mean aunts until a magic potion produces an enormous peach, which gives James a home as well as some wild adventures.
- JF Estes, Eleanor. **THE MOFFATS**
The four Moffat children live with their widowed mother in a small house, where even the most ordinary day is packed with extraordinary fun. (one of a series)
- JF Hoffman, Mary. **STARRING GRACE**
School is out and imaginative Grace turns her backyard into wonderful places for her friends to play.
- JF King-Smith, Dick. **BABE, THE GALLANT PIG**
Babe is going to be dinner at Farmer Hogget's until a sheepdog befriends her and teaches her to be a sheep herder.
- JF Lovelace, Maud Hart. **BETSY-TACY**
Five-year-old Betsy's dream comes true when Tacy moves in next door and they become best friends and share all the things that little girls love to do. (one of a series)
- JF MacBride, Roger Lea. **LITTLE HOUSE ON ROCKY RIDGE**
In 1894, Laura Ingalls Wilder, her husband, and her seven-year-old daughter Rose, leave their home in Dakota and make the long and difficult journey to Missouri to start a new life. (one of a series)
- JF MacDonald, Betty. **MRS. PIGGLE-WIGGLE**
The eccentric Mrs. Piggle-Wiggle lives in an upside-down house, loves all children-naughty and nice, and offers parents cures for common children's diseases such as "Won't-Put-Away-Toys-itis" and Answerbackism. (one of a series)
- JF Pellowski, Anne. **WILLOW WIND FARM: BETSY'S STORY**
This heartwarming story follows a year in the life of seven-year-old Betsy and her large family on their Wisconsin farm. (one of a series)
- JPb Peterson, John. **THE LITTLES**
Life can be dangerous for the Little family who live in the walls of the Bigg's house and are only a few inches tall. (one of a series)
- JF Smith, Janice Lee. **THE SHOW-AND-TELL WAR AND OTHER STORIES ABOUT ADAM JOSHUA**
Adam Joshua and the class bully keep trying to outdo each other's show-and-tell. (one of a series)
- JPb Steig, William. **DOMINIC**
